1703/15 | Existing Highways and Street Lighting Issues

Members were delighted by the news from Councillor John Williams that the Highways and Infrastructure Committee has allocated Teversham £37,000 from the 2017/2018 budget to resurface the school side of Church Road. Members thanked Councillor MacInnes and the Clerk for their work.

The school has written to all parents/carers to reiterate the dangers. It was agreed that the parish council will assist in any way they can. It was agreed that Councillor MacInnes will come back to the parish council with some ideas from the school that could include new bollards and providing disabled parking spaces.
